TITLE: Podcasting in the Curriculum.

TARGET AUDIENCE:

KS2, KS3, KS4

COURSE OUTLINE AND PURPOSE:

This course will look at the ways that podcasting can be used in the curriculum and go through how to create and set up podcasting in your classroom. Podcasting is an excellent tool to develop oral reading fluency and writing skills as students have to research, plan, and write the scripts in advance and complete multiple audio takes before they are satisfied that the quality is good enough for broadcasting.

The process of creating podcasts is very simple but effective. It can promote good writing, speaking, and communicating skills developing a sense of audience and purpose. Using podcasting in lessons can encourage active participation and student voice. It is also useful as a form of assessment.
