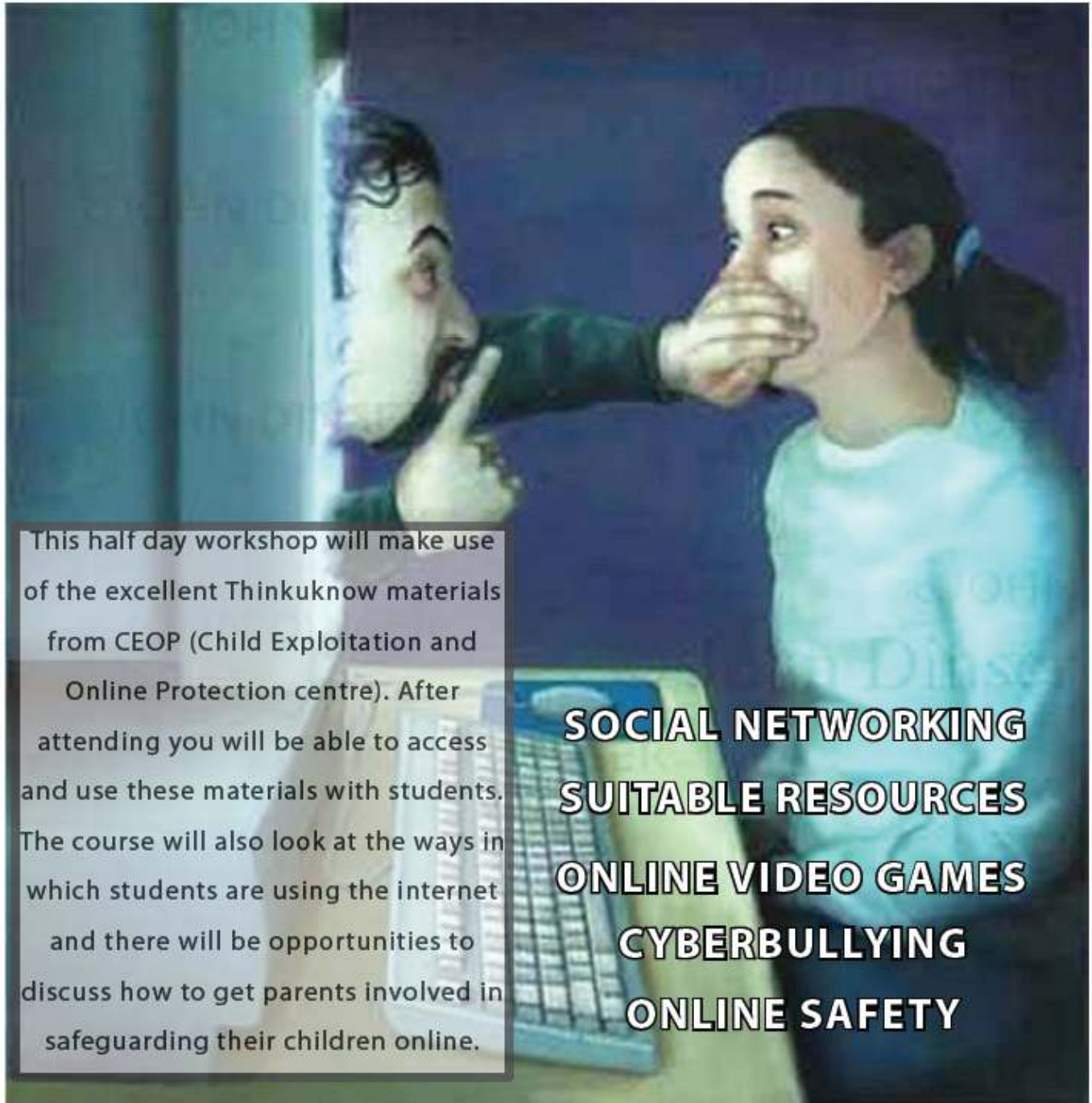


E SAFETY WORKSHOP

E-Safety Training Day

Use of the internet in schools is growing rapidly, and most children and young people use the internet every day. Whilst the internet is a fantastic resource, it is important that as educators we educate students to ensure that they are aware of the potential risks and are able to stay safe online.

Central Enfield City Learning Centre is offering a half day training session based around the theme of “**E-Safety; Safeguarding Children in a Digital World**”. This course aims to provide you with the knowledge of how to educate children and young people to stay safe in the digital world.

The course will provide the opportunity to review and explore the Thinkuknow materials produced by CEOP (Child Online Exploitation Centre). These materials have been designed for 5-7 year olds, 8-10 year olds and 11-16 year olds. Those attending the course will be able to access and use resources with colleagues, pupils and parents back at school. The session will also involve a discussion around issues of online safety.
